



# THE ENERGY CAPITAL OF BAY AREA HOUSTON



The energy industry contributes more than half a trillion dollars to the Texas economy each year, according to the Texas Oil and Gas Association. The Wink to Webster Pipeline, a 650-mile-long pipeline system, transports more than one million barrels of sweet crude oil and condensate from Wink, Texas, to Webster daily, ranking it as the largest long-haul crude pipeline in the United States.

The Webster station has an astounding 2.5 million barrels of storage tank space—pumping more oil than any other station in the country. Webster receives deliveries from West Texas, Houston, and offshore Gulf of Mexico and transfers product to Baytown Refinery and three Houston area third-party pipeline systems.

Texas Tech University’s Center for Energy Commerce estimates the Wink to Webster Pipeline System will generate \$10.6 billion of economic output and contribute \$769 million of state and local taxes over 40 years of operations.
