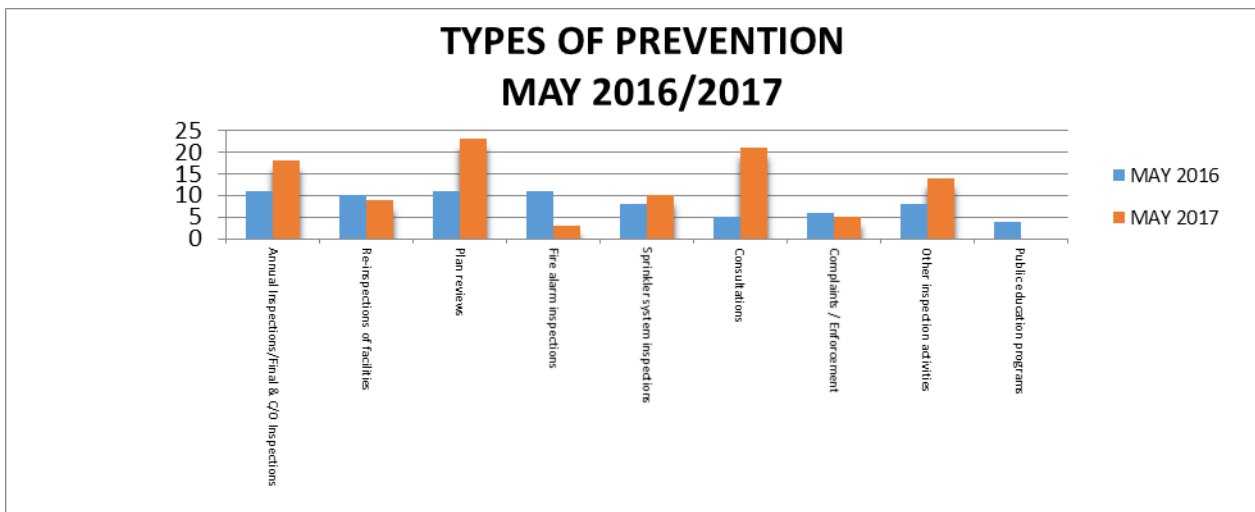


FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE

Dive Response:

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit received no requests for response during May 2017.
