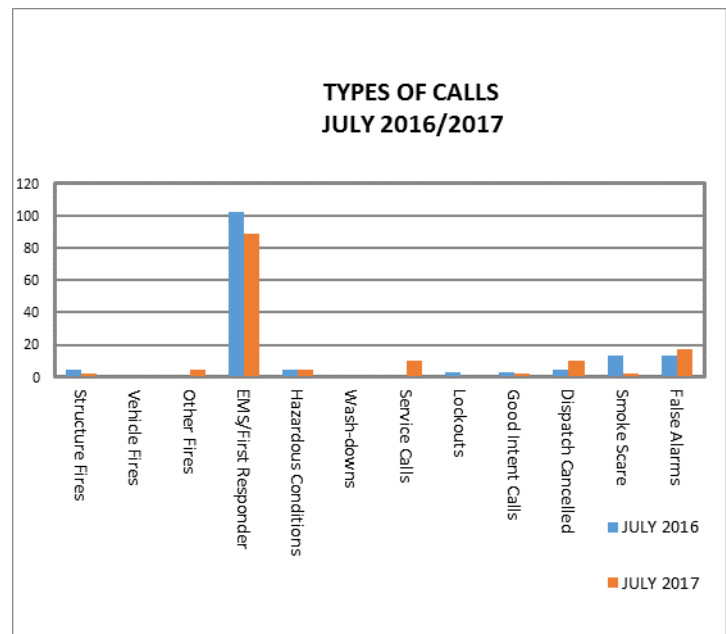

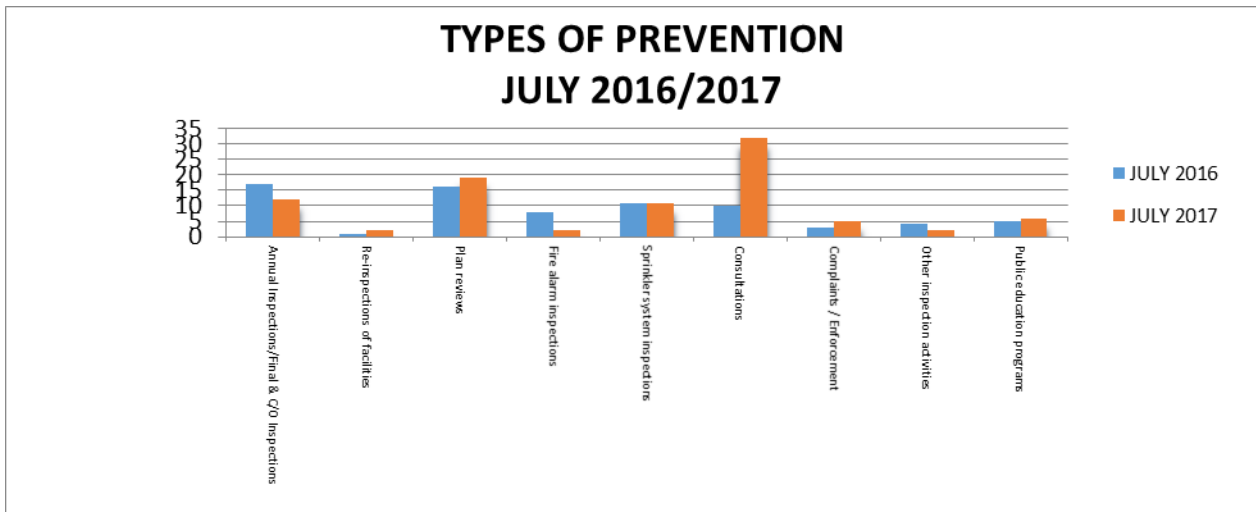


FIRE PREVENTION DEPARTMENT UPDATE

WFD – Special Operations Report - July 2017

Dive Response:

1. The Webster Special Operations Unit received no requests for response during July 2017.

Training:

5. Discussed specifications for proposed dive boat.
6. Discussed purchase of additional dive gear to outfit new team members.
7. Discussed scheduling rescue dive skills for August 4-5, 2017.

Car Seats:

1. The Webster Fire Department CPS technicians assisted with four (4) car-seat installations during July 2017. Car-seat installations are handled as needed at the fire station, and through participation at special events held at the fire station and outside venues.
